

How to clean your CritterZone

CritterZone Air Naturalizers can collect dust and other pollutants over time. Often a simple swipe with a tissue or cotton swab between the grill cover slats will be sufficient. However, if you look through the grill guard and see debris collecting on the two metallic points inside, a more thorough cleaning should be done to help keep your CritterZone unit running efficiently.

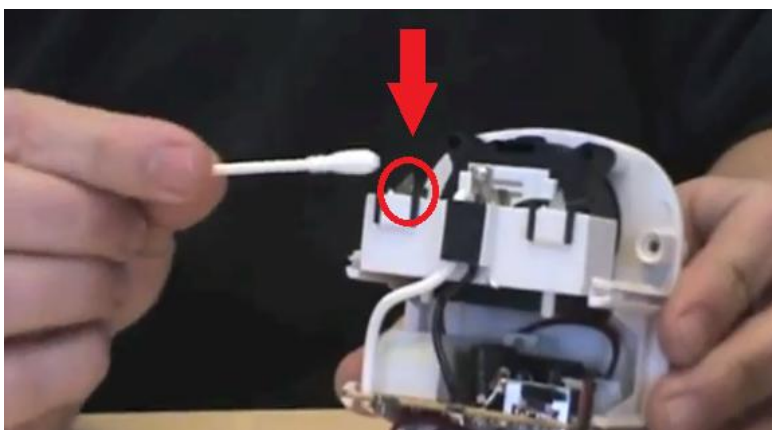

STEP 1: Unplug the unit. Take the rubber pads off the back. Underneath each is a screw to remove:



STEP 2: Once those have been removed, take off the cover. Use a cotton swab to clean debris from the front grill slats on the cover. You also may need to clean the inside of the cover with a damp cloth.

STEP 3: Dip a clean cotton swab in soap and water. Use the swab to brush off the metal triangular points, as seen below.

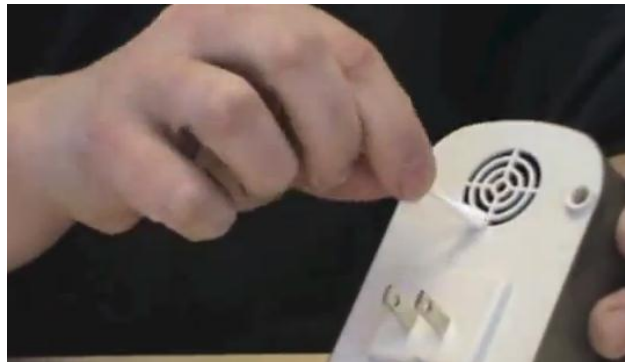


If there is buildup stuck to the triangular points, gently loosen the residue with the tip of a screwdriver.

STEP 4: Use a damp cotton swab to clean off the white card with the two silver lines on it, as pictured in the photo below:



STEP 5: Clear the back air intake guard of dust and debris, using a cotton swab:



Once everything is dry, you can reassemble the unit by putting the cover back on and replacing the screws and rubber stops. Your CritterZone is ready to continue using.
