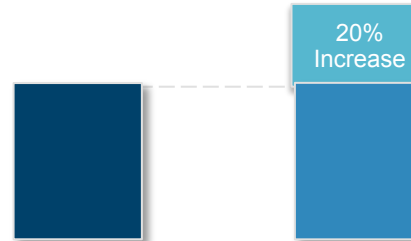
## Cargo Fleet Transition
