

Testimony CSHB 77- Land Disposals/Exchanges: Water Rights Friday, March 14, 2014

Good evening Madam Chairman and members of the committee. Thank you for extending public testimony so we all have an opportunity to speak. For the record, my name is Rachael Petro and I serve as the president and CEO of the Alaska Chamber. You have maybe heard us referred to as corporate shills earlier in testimony.
