APPLING COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULAR MEETING JANUARY 7, 2014 5:30 P.M.

The Regular Meeting of the Appling County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Lewis Parker on Tuesday, January 7, 2014 at 5:30 p.m. Present were Commissioners Charlie Leggett, Daryl Edwards, Ronnie Rentz, Sarah Boatright and Theodore Wilkerson and Commissioner Chairman Lewis Parker. Also present was County Manager Lee Lewis, County Attorney Bob Highsmith and County Clerk Chrissy Harris. Present from the news media were Jamie Gardner of the Baxley News Banner, Al Graham from WBYZ Radio Station and Joe Taylor from the TSA (Technology Student Association).

Commissioner Boatright led the pledge to the flag.

Commissioner Leggett gave the invocation.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Commissioner Leggett and seconded by Commissioner Edwards to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting held on December 3, 2013. Motion carried unanimously.

PUPLIC INPUT

Al Graham addressed the Board in reference to the County purchasing the Lake Tara Property and expressed his concern that \$750,000 of County funds is being used for the purchase of the property. Mr. Graham suggested that the Board hold a special meeting to hear input from citizens of the county on how they feel about the purchase of the Lake Tara Property by the County.

Many people addressed the Board in reference to the County rescinding the Beer and Wine License Ordinance. Those that gave input on this issue were: Attorney David McRae (on behalf of the Appling County War Veteran's Club), Ronald Ryals, Robert Gardner, Joel Chew, Jimmy Wise, Janet Leggett, Ellen Mansfield, Barbara Baucom and Bob Berger.

OLD BUSINESS

SOLID WASTE CONTRACT RENEWAL

County Manager Lee Lewis reported that the Solid Waste Contract with Republic Services was up for renewal. The rates for monthly residential pickup will remain at \$39.75 per quarter and Republic Services will be handling the billing and the collection of solid waste pickup. The commercial contract requiring local businesses to use Republic Services for commercial trash pick up has been removed from the contract.

A motion was made by Commissioner Boatright and seconded by Commissioner Leggett to approve the Solid Waste Contract renewal with Sullivan Environmental Services. Motion carried unanimously.

HEALTH INSURANCE RENEWAL

VEHICLE PURCHASE - ROAD DEPARTMENT, EMA

County Manager Lee Lewis reported that EMA Director Dane Bruce has selected a Ford Explorer Police Interceptor from the State Contract List for the replacement of the EMA vehicle that was recently totaled.

A motion was made by Commissioner Leggett and seconded by Commissioner Rentz to approve the purchase of the 2014 Ford Police Interceptor Utility vehicle from Woody Folsom Ford in the amount of \$24,850.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Lewis also reported that state contract prices have been obtained for Road Superintendent Tommy Davis and Road Projects Manager Hayden Rozier. After the purchase of these vehicles, the truck currently being used by Road Superintendent Tommy Davis can be passed down to be used in the truck fleet at the County Road Department.
