

CALLED COUNCIL MEETING

A Called Meeting of the Baxley City Council was held July 12, 2016, at 6:00 p.m., with the following members present: Mayor Steve Rigdon; Mayor Pro Tem Dr. Esco Hall, Jr.; Councilmembers: Betty Livingston, George Skipper, Pat Williams, Mickey Bass, and Tim Varnadore.

City officials present were: Jeff Baxley, City Manager, Reba Cash, City Clerk and James Godfrey, Chief of Police.

No members of the public were present.

Councilwoman Livingston gave the invocation.

Mayor Rigdon called the Baxley City Council to order on this the 12th day of July, 2016, at 6:00 p.m., for the primary purpose of holding a public hearing.

Mayor Rigdon called the public hearing to order at 6:00 p.m. for the purpose of hearing public comments on an application for annexation petition filed by Yvette D. Shipwash, requesting her property located at 112 Wanda Road, be annexed and establishing a Residential (R-15) Zone in voting District #4.

There were no questions or comments from the Council.

Mayor Pro Tem Hall made a motion to accept City Manager Baxley's recommendation to utilize funds from the TIA discretionary fund to pay curb and gutter replacement on Anthony Street, and for milling and overlay work to be done on Wood Street from Anthony to Floyd Street. The combined cost for both Anthony and Wood Streets is \$19,189.00. This motion was seconded by Councilwoman Livingston are carried unanimously.

There being no further business, Mayor Rigdon declared the meeting adjourned.
