

## REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Baxley City Council was held on July 26, 2016, at 8:30 a.m., with the following members present: Mayor Steve Rigdon; Mayor Pro Tem Esco Hall, Jr.; Councilmembers: Betty Livingston, Mickey Bass, Pat Williams, George Skipper and Tim Varnadore.

Other city officials present were: Reba Cash, City Clerk; and Alex Johnson, City Attorney.

Steve Simmons representing Baxley News Banner was present.

Mayor Rigdon called the Regular Council Meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

Councilman Varnadore gave the invocation.

Councilwoman Livingston made a motion approving the minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of July 12, 2016, at 8:30 a.m. This motion was seconded by Councilman Bass and carried unanimously.

Councilman Varnadore made a motion approving the minutes of the Called Council Meeting of July 12, 2016, at 6:00 p.m. This motion was seconded by Councilman Williams and carried unanimously.

Ima Dean Sapp of Jan and Dean Beauty Salon addressed the Mayor and Council on behalf of her elderly customers needing special parking. She stated on numerous occasions she has had to assist them as they walk down Tippins Street to get in and out of their vehicles. After 25 years the parking has been gotten worse each year. One customer was almost struck by a vehicle. She hopes installing a speed bump will help slow down traffic. Mayor Rigdon stated the City understands her concern, and will look into this problem.

Councilman Varnadore made a motion approving the First Reading of an Ordinance annexing property filed by Yvette D. Shipwash requesting her property located at 112 Wanda Road be annexed and establishing a Residential (R-15) Zone in voting district #4. This motion was seconded by Councilman Bass and carried unanimously.

Councilman Varnadore made a motion to table naming three (3) nominees for the vacant position to present to the Baxley Hospital Board until the next regular council meeting. This motion was seconded by Councilman Bass and carried unanimously.
