## CALLED COUNCIL MEETING

A Called Meeting of the Baxley City Council was held January 12, 2016, at 6:00 p.m., with the following members present: Mayor Steve Rigdon; Mayor Pro Tem, Dr. Esco Hall, Jr. Councilmembers: Betty Livingston, Pat Williams, Mickey Bass, and Tim Varnadore.

City officials present were: Jeff Baxley, City Manager, Reba Cash, City Clerk and James Godfrey, Chief of police

Mayor Rigdon called the Baxley City Council to order on this the 12<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2016, at 6:00 p.m., for the primary purpose of holding a public hearing.

Councilwoman Livingston gave the invocation.

Mayor Rigdon called the public hearing to order at 6:00 p.m. for the followings:

1. The purpose of this meeting is to hear public comments on a petition for annexation filed by Tobias Montano, requesting his property located at 770 Harry Street be annexed and established a Business Residential (BR-1) Zone.

Mayor Pro Tem Hall asked if a business was to be located there. City Manager explained that this is a Business/Residential zone and that either could go there. It is our understanding that this will be a resident.

The purpose of this meeting is to hear public comments on a petition for zoning amendment filed by Joel Gregory Herrin, requesting his property located at 549 Tippins Street be rezoned from the current Residential (RM-10) to a Business (B-2) Zone.

City Manager explained the process which is required by law to hold a public hearing to give the public the opportunity to comment. He also stated that no action is taken at this public hearing and that it will come before the council at their next regular meeting on January 26, 2016.
