Washer Rules

1. Washers will be played in a sand pit with no box.
2. Pit will have a cup measuring 4" in diameter.
3. Cups will be 21 foot from center of cup to center of cup.
4. Oldest player will throw first in the match.
5. Host will provide washers.
6. Only one player can score per round.
7. In the cup is 5 points, a washer leaning over the cup is 3 points, and all washers closest to the hole than your opponent will score 1 point.
8. Cover of points is in play. Player A cups a washer and Player B cups. Those washers wash and 0 points would be awarded.
9. Washers will be thrown from behind, beside or no more than one step in front of the cup.
10. Skunk is in Play. Player A scores 11 in match before Player B score any points. That would be a skunk.
11. Whitewash Rule will be in play. Player A score 17 point and Player B score 3 points. A whitewash can be called.
12. Bust Rule not in play.
13. To win player must beat opponent by 2 points or more. Player A is a 20, Player B must score at least 22 points to win. Player A is at 17 and Player B is at 21. Player B is awarded the win.
14. If Player A hits 21, Player A will stop their round. Player B will start their round. If Player B scores and puts Player A below 21, Player B will stop play and Player A will continue with remaining washers. Then Player B will throw remaining washers.
15. Use of opponents' washers is in play. Player A hits 21 on first washer tossed, Player B will get Players A's remaining 3 washers. Player A's washer will not go to Player B till Player A has tossed all their washers first.
16. Player that score points in the last round will throw first in the next round.
