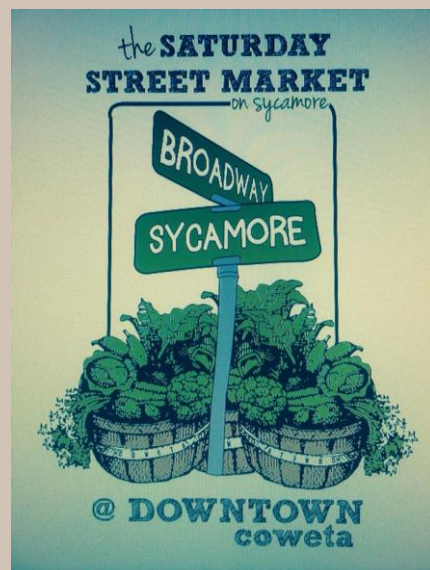
Saturday Street Market June 13th

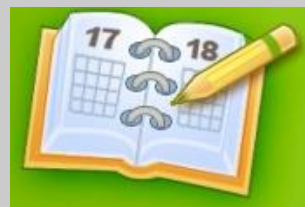
