Each day begins with devotions.

Morning hours will be spent in music instruction. Each camper will study two instruments. All of these sessions are designed for beginners or those with little previous instruction. Please check the two desired instruments of study.

_____Guitar (18 , max.) Do you own a guitar? _____If not, you will be playing on a church instrument. *Chris Brown instructor.*

_____Harp (12 max.) You will be playing miniature harps (harpsicles) owned by the church. *Vicki Smith, instructor.*

_____Violin (18, max.) Do you own a violin? _____If not, you will be playing a violin that the church owns or has rented. *Eric Samuelson, instructor.*

_____Trumpet (10, max.) Do you own a trumpet?_____ If not, you will be playing a trumpet owned by the church. Each child will have their own mouthpiece. *Ben Hay, instructor.*

_____Handbells (20, max) You will be playing handbells owned by the church. *Lynn Beaird, instructor.*

_____Ukulele (10, max) You will be playing an ukulele owned by the church. *Karl Sewiert, instructor.*

Know that the guitar, violin and ukulele require similar motion from the left hand. Be aware of this in choice of instruments.

In the middle of the morning and afternoon all campers will have a short camp choir rehearsal.

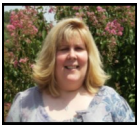

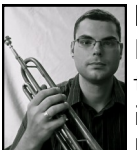
Chris Brown: Guitar Instructor
