

The Peace Kite

In 2009 the world lost a wonderful person, Mary Krantz. Mary was an associate of the Franciscan Sisters and a friend to many in the Little Falls community. She was a great supporter of the Green Fair Folk Festival and to remember her and honor her spirit, the peace kite was created by Lost Lake Design in 2010.

Mary had a love for kites and in celebrating her life she shared some of her joy by writing these words . . .

Wind is our Spirit Sister, it represents the breath of life in us; wind creates the waves that we love to listen to as they crash on shore; winds carry the smells of the seasons to us; and wind may someday help us to stop killing the planet. Wind is also necessary for flying kites.

Mary liked kites. She felt they were a lot like people. Kites come in many different sizes, shapes and colors. Like people they can bring us much joy, but they are also easily hurt especially when they're brought

down to earth. To achieve their potential, kites must leave the safety of Mother Earth and reach for the heavens. There they are free to dazzle and delight us. Thought buffeted by winds, kites are resilient as long as they remain airborne. Likewise, we humans must leave the safety of our comfort zones to realize our full potential. We too are resilient as long as we stay airborne — as long as the line that connects us to our human network remains unbroken. Kites amaze and thrill us — just like those we love.

Mary believed deeply in spreading the message of peace and taking care of our planet. We are blessed to know she is watching over us and our time together here tonight.




