Your chamber had a very interesting year in 2013, and I think it was well celebrated at our Annual Holiday Luncheon this past December. Wonderful things happen all year long in Granville, but one event was outstanding! It happened in September when Denison University announced that it would be purchasing the Granville Inn. The Inn had been struggling for several years and had spent the last year in receivership. Fortunately, the community can continue to claim the Granville Inn as one of our historic businesses and landmarks for future generations. Denison University saved the 86-year-old facility, along with some 35 jobs, and for having done so was honored by the GACC as the “2013 Business of the Year.”

Many chamber members give of their time and talents on committees and special projects throughout the year. Volunteers are the life blood of the chamber. For one whole year, Granville resident, Kathy Tatham, spent two days a week working in the chamber office. Alan Hoffmann shared time and energy ensuring the Annual Golf Outing and fundraiser would be successful again this year. Both deserved recognition of their contributions to the chamber and were awarded “2013 Volunteer of the Year.”

November’s election of the board of directors resulted in beginning new three-year terms for the following: Tom Argyle, of Licking Memorial Health Systems; Lisa Englefield, of Elms Pizza Parlor; and Don Jones, of the Orchard House Bed and Breakfast. Tobin Mann, of Mann Legal Services, will be continuing the remaining two years of Alan Hoffmann’s three-year term. I would like to thank Ashley Wade, of Kendal at Granville, for completing my remaining term as board chair upon my accepting the position of executive director.

We also gave Maggie Barno a heartfelt tribute at the Holiday Luncheon. Her accomplishments in growing the chamber over the last six years

Diana K. Jones, owner of Granville Carriage Company, LLC, unexpectedly passed away on Monday, December 16, 2013. Diana was well known for her beautiful white carriage and horses, especially Toby, a white Percheron, which, for nearly ten years, frequented the streets of Granville for a variety of events and celebrations.

Diana is survived by her husband Watson R. Jones; two children and two grandchildren. She lived on Battee Road, in Granville.

Granville Carriage Company became a member of the GACC in 2007. The iconic images of Diana in her elegant costumes and fancy hats, driving her beautiful white carriage with Toby, will be sadly missed in Granville.

Teresa Mae Peters, co-owner of The Going Green Store, of River Road, Granville, passed away peacefully on Monday, December 16, 2013, after a long battle with cancer. Teresa was an award winning change-maker, a lawyer by trade, and all around do-gooder. She lived and worked all over the world helping to change lives and create hope. From the OEC in Paris, France, to her own foundation, Bridges.org, in South Africa, to The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation in Seattle, WA, and yet ultimately she returned home to Licking County to write the final chapter of her too short but well-lived life.

Teresa is survived by her “boys,” Harry and Gordon; her sisters Wendy and Jill, nieces and nephew, Amy, Katie, Payge, and Tyler; her life and business partner Mike Bauer, and his kids Hannah and Luke.

A gathering of friends and family was held at The Going Green Store on Friday, December 27, to celebrate Teresa. The Going Green Store joined the GACC in July, 2011. Although Teresa's legacy continues, her presence in Granville will be noticeably missed.

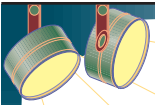
