The 14th Annual River Festival was held on August 14th and 15th, 2015 with the majority of the events taking place on the historical Expedition Island. The event was held in conjunction with Art on the Green. Overall participation exceeded 4,000 participants from all over Wyoming and 24 different States and Canada. Over 150 people competed in the Run with the Horses Marathon. There were 15 Hand Craft Vendors, two food vendors, two shaved ice vendors, two bands, 900

pounds of shrimp, a Micro-Brew Garden, Corn hole, Ladder Ball, several Kids Games, Fireworks, a Duck Race, the Run with the Horses Marathon, Green Belt Mountain Bike Poker Run, a River Walk, Dog Fetching Competitions, a Dog Show, and a Car Show. There was plenty of entertainment for all ages! We would like to thank all of our volunteers and all of our sponsors for the 14th Annual River Festival; without them, this event would not have happened!

River Walk

Seedskadee Trout Unlimited had another successful year hosting our Riverwalk. We like to say we put the river back in Riverfest. There were over 60 participants complete all the



stations. It was down considerably from last year. We attribute that to that fact that we started the event earlier this year in an attempt to beat the heat. We had eight stations this year, down from eleven last year. We purposely cut the distance and the amount of stations but it still took over two hours on average to complete the activity. That shows that people were very engaged in learning.

We couldn't have done it without our dedicated partners. A huge thank you goes out to our Wyoming Game and Fish Department. They ran four of the stations: Fish Obstacle Course, Fish on the Green River, Aquatic Invasive Species, and Wildlife & Riparian Areas stations. The Green River Fire Department was out in force at the Water and River Safety Station. The Seedskadee National Wildlife Refuge taught about Migrating Birds and Riparian Areas. They brought with them six volunteers from the Conservation Corp. Our Seedskadee Trout Unlimited helped people identify aquatic invertebrates. The Wyoming Wildlife & Natural Resource Trust ran the invasive species Scavenger Hunt and donated two back packs that were given away as door prizes. Mike Babcock won the hat, water bottle and jacket donated by the Muley Fanatics Foundation. The Riverfest Committee allowed us to present the Grand Prize at our event which consisted of an all-day Whitewater float and one night stay at the Wind River Casino. Aja Witt, of Green River, won that.

Kitchen Safety



The summer is almost over and so alas, is BBQ season. As all of your cooking begins to move back indoors, the City of Green River's Fire Department wants you to stay safe. People in the United States are more likely to experience a fire in their home than anywhere else. According to research conducted by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA), one out of three home fires begins in the kitchen.

Preparing a meal can be hectic from timing ingredients to the phone ringing to the kids needing attention. With these added pressures, it's no wonder we can be distracted when cooking. Every day when we prepare meals, we are at risk of a cooking fire. Here are a few tips to help keep you safe.

Watch what you heat; stay in the kitchen when you fry, grill or boil. When you simmer, bake or boil stay in your home or apartment; if you have to leave, turn off the stove. Keep things that can catch fire away from the stove top, like pot holders, bags and boxes and towels and curtains. Make a three foot "kid-free zone" around the stove and where hot food and drink is prepared. Read the instructions and use all of your kitchen appliances correctly, and make sure your home fire alarms are working.
