
Taste of Hilliard & Business Expo

Ten Pin Alley Has New Lanes



After 50 plus years, the all wood lanes at Hilliard's **Ten Pin Alley** are making the change to a synthetic overlay. **Ten Pin Alley** is one of the last all wood centers in Columbus.

To put it frankly, back in the day, all lanes were wood. But then in the 80's, a new synthetic material was invented; a pressed paper product which acted as a new type of lane - longer lasting and easier to maintain.

Every couple years any center with all wood lanes would need to sand and smooth their lanes. Even though the oil used daily on bowling lanes helps protect them, they do get banged up quite a bit resulting in numerous dents, bumps and scratches - imagine a 14 pound weight thrown thousands of times and you'll get the idea. So every couple years the lanes would require a fine sanding along the length of the lane, followed by a new polishing and chemical sealant. However you can only sand so many times over the course of decades until the wood is too thin for use.

In addition to the new look and feel, the synthetic lanes POP a lot more under black lights, providing a nice glow for late night bowling. Go and roll some balls on the new lanes at 5499 Constitution Boulevard!


