 - Meet with Nominating Committee and President-Elect to discuss the leadership needs of the Council and other elected positions.
 - Serve as a Leader of the Executive Committee.
 - Provide leadership to the Council and Congregation in support of the mission and ministry of the Congregation.
 - Serve on the Personnel Committee and with the President Elect, conduct performance reviews for the Lead Pastor.
 - Call special meetings as required.
 - Ensure Constitutional Committees are functioning.
