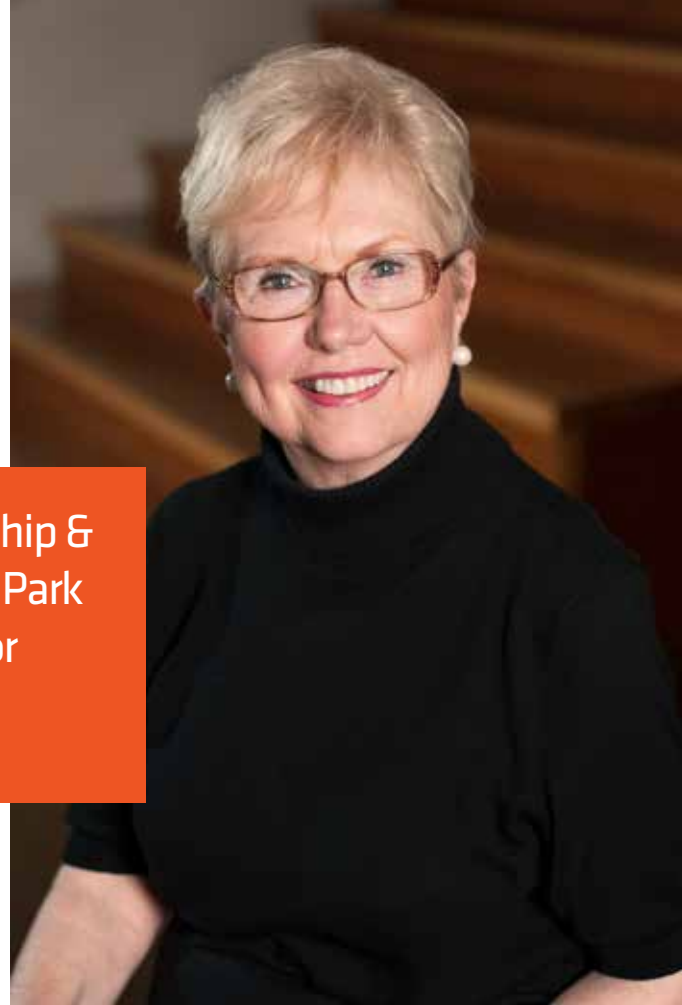

Elected in 1999 as Kansas City's first woman mayor; re-elected in 2003, the Honorable Kay Barnes led initiatives while in office which have produced more than \$4.5 billion in public and private investment in Kansas City, MO. Since being term limited in May of 2007, Barnes has served on numerous corporate and non-profit boards including the Mid-America GLCC. Currently Barnes serves as the Distinguished Professor for Public Leadership & Founding Director at the Center for Leadership located at Park University.

The Barnes Leadership Series is a substantive 10 session course series and coaching program.
