

Innovation Team

Tech Titans Innovation Team Programs include interactive bi-monthly and semi-annual events focused exclusively on the promotion of the DFW high-tech industry, innovation and entrepreneurship. Events include bi-monthly "Next Big Thing" speaker series, where entrepreneurs and early-stage company executives introduce new break-through technologies, products or services that could revolutionize a business or industry sector. Lunch time events are held on the third Thursday every other month starting in February except December. Average attendance is 40 per luncheon. Twice per year the Innovation Team produces a Reverse Pitch event to foster interaction between large corporations, entrepreneurs and start-ups, possibly resulting in business transactions, corporate investments or acquisitions. This program consists of large company executives from product groups or corporate investment groups pitching what technology solutions their companies are interested in and how to engage with them if an entrepreneur or startup company has such a solution. Previous Reverse Pitch events have drawn as many as 175 attendees.
