## **Kid's Club: Ages 4-6**

**Musical Explorers:** Music & Movement class is created to prepare your child for success in private or group instrument lessons. **Group Piano Classes:** Created to build a space for beginners interested in learning piano, this class will cover all the basics needed to get a head start as an up-and-coming pianist. Students will be introduced to piano in an exciting environment that will expose students to the wide variety of skills needed to be a pianist in both solo and group settings. ***Piano 2 Pre-Requisite: Piano 1 or RMC Placement Assessment***

**Uke Jams:** Master the ukulele basics and learn repertoire covering a variety of styles, and have a blast while you're at it! Jam with friends on an instrument that delivers results. No uke? No problem! Borrow one of ours, or purchase your own ukulele and case from RMC for \$100.

**Group Guitar Classes:** Group guitar classes are catered towards the older beginner, eager to get a head start on reading guitar chords and learning notation. In this class, students will master basic strumming patterns, read single-note guitar notation, and learn the chords needed to play a myriad of rock or pop tunes!
