Please note that **candy and other items need to be handed out to parade spectators, not tossed.** This is to ensure that the parade will be an enjoyable and safe experience for everyone involved.

Also, **please review the enclosed River Falls Days Parade Policy Snapshot.** We created these guidelines based on feedback from participants, spectators, and marching band coordinators. Our goal is to keep the parade moving at a steady pace so it is more enjoyable for everyone. *** If your parade unit includes animals, you must provide your own clean up crew.*

If your group still needs to hand in **waivers**, please give them to a parade volunteer on the evening of the parade. A waiver form is included here for your convenience. Please note: Announcements for the parade judges that are handed in the Wednesday prior to the parade day of the parade are not guaranteed to be read during the parade.

RIVER FALLS DAYS PARADE POLICY SNAPSHOT
--

Please review this carefully and observe these rules so we can continue to maintain a safe, high-quality parade

Please share this information with the float driver and all participants of the float.

- Drivers of motorized vehicles ***must*** be at least 16 years of age and have a valid drivers' license.
- Maintain steady, forward motion throughout the parade route, except in cases where safety may be in an issue. ***Moving vehicles cannot wait for walkers; walkers must keep up.***
- **Candy or other give-aways must not be thrown from moving vehicles.**
- **All entries with livestock must have their own waste removal equipment immediately following their unit. Units without waste removal equipment will be moved to the end of the parade.**
- Maintain a distance of no more than one-half block between your unit and the one in front of you (or up to one full block, if the unit in front of yours is a school marching band).
- Please be prepared to adjust your pace in order to close gaps that may be created by parade units in front of you.
- If a marching band is in the Judging Area on 2nd Street, you may not enter it until the marching band has exited ***completely.***
- **Horns, sirens or loud sounds of any kind** are prohibited while a marching band is in the Judging Area.
- **Excessively loud horns, sirens or loud sounds of any kind** are prohibited during the parade. Please be mindful of spectators in choosing a volume.
- Spraying water from squirt guns, hoses, etc., toward the Reviewing Stand is strictly prohibited. Please do not spray younger/older parade spectators – they may not enjoy it!
- **If you are the parade coordinator for your business or organization, it is your responsibility to provide the Parade Policy to ALL participants in your parade unit.**

Your full cooperation with Parade Officials in the staging area and along the entire parade route will be expected. The Chamber and/or Parade Officials reserve the right to remove parade units at any time for failure to comply with any portion of the parade policy.

Addendum to Resolution No. 3649

CITY OF RIVER FALLS

**Parade Rules
(Section 12.10 of Municipal Code)**

No person, firm, association, group of persons, organization or corporation taking part in a parade will be allowed to do any of the following:

- Throw any object, including candy, toys, leaflets, etc., from moving vehicles.
- Canvas parade route as a street vendor while parade is in progress.
- Motor vehicle operators in parade must hold a valid operator's license. This includes all golf carts, lawn mowers, etc.
- Parade participant shall not have any portion of parade unit higher than 13'6".
- Parade participant shall not operate unit at a speed or in such a manner that unreasonably endangers the safety of occupants, spectators, or other participants.
- Parade units utilizing live animals shall be prepared and are responsible for removing and disposing of animal waste. Animals shall be closely supervised and under the control of the owner/designee.
- Parade applications shall include the following information:
 - Date - Time
 - Assembly/Disassembly Area
 - Special Parking/Street Closing Requests
 - Contact Person to Coordinate the Event
- Parade participant or spectator will not engage in behavior that unreasonably endangers the safety of any person at the event. This includes riding on or clinging to a parade unit in a manner likely to cause injury.
- The River Falls Police Department has express authority to regulate behavior/operation of any parade unit, operator or spectator in the interest of safety for the event. Police personnel have authority to remove and/or issue citations to any person/unit or spectator not conforming to these rules.

2016 River Falls Days Parade Participation Waiver River Falls Area Chamber of Commerce & Tourism Bureau

I, the undersigned, have agreed for my own benefit to participate in various events and activities during the year 2016 in connection with and/or under the directions of the River Falls Days celebration and the River Falls Area Chamber of Commerce & Tourism Bureau.

I understand that inherent in my participation in such events and activities, such events to be included without limitation, parades, is the risk of serious personal injury and property damage to myself and all others under my direction and control, and to my property under my direction and control. I hereby waive and release any claim I have or may have in the future against River Falls Days or the River Falls Area Chamber of Commerce & Tourism Bureau, and any of their officers, whether or not caused in whole or in part by negligence of such officer, directors, employees, agents and volunteers, which occurs during or as a result of my participation in any of the events and activities held in connections with and/or under the director of the above-referenced entities. I understand that the negligence of myself, or a participant, results in injury to others or damage to property, the River Falls Area Chamber of Commerce & Tourism Bureau shall be held harmless and will indemnify the participant. Furthermore, in the event I agree to operate a vehicle in connection with any of the events and activities held in connection with and/or under direction of River Falls Days and the River Falls Area Chamber of Commerce & Tourism Bureau, I represent that I am validly licensed to drive such vehicle in the events and /or activities and that I have purchased automobile insurance and have liability limits of at least \$100,000/\$300,000.

All participants, including unit drivers, float personnel, members of novelty units, and riders and drivers of horse units must sign and submit this form to the River Falls Area Chamber of Commerce & Tourism Bureau prior to the event specified. Organizations must make additional copies of this form for signature by each participant and return prior to the parade.
