
In November 2016, the Chamber surveyed its members on the issue of carbon pricing and our members made it clear that the Chamber should continue to support the provincial government's opposition to the implementation of a federal carbon pricing scheme and also advocate for technological investments and incentives to reduce emissions.

The Government of Saskatchewan is being proactive in creating a plan that will be better aligned with the unique characteristics of our province and economy as opposed to the imposition of a carbon tax.

While some details of your government's plan remain to be seen, the presentation that we received from Mr. David Brock and Ms. Sharla Hordenchuk provided enough information that we are comfortable offering our support for the plan that will soon be announced.

We would welcome a meeting with you and Ministry officials at your earliest convenience to discuss how the Chamber might offer additional public support of the plan.
