South Padre Island Chamber of Commerce 2017 LKT Tournament Rules - Bay Division

- 1. All participants in the 2017 Ladies Kingfish Tournament must comply with the Tournament Rules set forth by the Committee. Participants assume full responsibility for checking and knowing the rules. IGFA rules apply in addition to Tournament rules stated in this document and at registration.
- 2. All Anglers on the boat and Captains, Boat Operators, Deckhands, Guests must be formally registered with the Tournament.
- 3. All participants must register the boat they will be fishing on <u>by name</u>. <u>THIS IS A BOAT TOURNAMENT. NO FISHING FROM DOCKS</u>. If you must switch boats due to mechanical problems, the LKT Committee must be notified.
- 4. Women anglers only. Men may participate, but only as Captains, Boat Operators, Deckhands or Guests.
- 5. <u>Men may not fish at any time during the Tournament</u>. Captains, Boat Operators, Deckhands or Guests may bait the hook or release the fish, but may not hold the rod at anytime.
- 6. Only one rod per angler is allowed in the water at one time. Anglers are not allowed to handle another angler's rod while fishing, this includes casting.
- 7. <u>IDENTIFY FISH BEFORE REACHING WEIGH-IN DOCK.</u> All fish must be in fresh, edible condition. <u>ANGLER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROPER IDENTIFICATION OF THEIR CATCH PRIOR TO ARRIVING AT THE DOCK.</u>

 <u>IMPROPER IDENTIFICATION OF CATCH WILL RESULT IN ANGLER DISQUALIFICATION.</u> Color rubber bands will be supplied at registration to assist with proper identification of each anglers fish (i.e.:1st angler red, 2nd angler blue, etc.) Anglers are responsible for transferring fish from their boat onto the dock. Dockhands will assist when fish are on the dock.
- 8. All fish must be caught by rod and reel. No gigging. No surf fishing. No fishing from piers, docks or jetties. Wade fishing permitted from boat only and each angler must remain within 100 yds. of their boat.
- 9. Fishing time begins no earlier than 6:30 a.m.
- 10. Weigh-In time begins at 1:00 p.m. and ends at 3:30 p.m., at SouthPoint Marina, Port Isabel. *No exceptions*. All fish brought in by land must be at the weigh station NO LATER THAN 3:30 p.m. Random fish will be cut open. All boats must be *AT THE DOCK* NO LATER THAN 3:30 p.m. Clock at dock will be official time. Dock Chief's decision is final. No fish will be weighed in for boats/anglers arriving late.
- 11. Qualifying fish are Red Drum, Speckled Trout and Flounder. No other fish will be weighed.
- 12. Bag limits are one fish per species per angler. Please practice conservation when possible.
- 13. <u>Size Limits</u>: No tagged Red Drum over 28" allowed. If an untagged Red Drum over 28" is brought in, the angler will be disqualified from the Tournament. No trout over 25" inches will be allowed.
- 14. Tournament weigh-card must be initialed by the angler when the fish are weighed in and prior to leaving the weigh station tent. Fish will only be weighed in one time. Angler initials indicate agreement with the information on the weigh-card.
- 15. Winning fish for each species are determined by heaviest weight. Ties are decided by length, then by weigh-in time. To be eligible for Grand Champion all three species must be weighed. In the event no one brings in all three, the heavier of two species will determine Grand Champion, etc.
- 16. Removal/disposal of all fish caught is the responsibility of the angler. Charity collectors will be on site.
- 17. Grievances must be <u>filed in writing</u> to the South Padre Island Chamber of Commerce office at 610 Padre Blvd. between 7:00 p.m. 9:00 p.m., August 12, 2017. The decision of the Grievance Committee is final. Person filing grievance must be available between 6:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m., Sunday, August 13, 2017 for questioning by Tournament Polygrapher.
- 18. Anglers and Captains, Boat Operators, Deckhands and Guests agree to submit to a polygraph test if requested by the Tournament Directors. Tests administered between 6:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Sunday, August 13, 2017. Refusal to take test upon request will result in disqualification from the tournament. Polygraph results of fail or inconclusive will result in disqualification from the Tournament, and future LKT Tournaments.
- 19. It is the duty of all persons entered in the Tournament to be familiar with State and Federal fishing regulations.
- 20. Anyone attempting to defraud the Tournament will be disqualified for life.
- 21. Special notice: Officials from Texas Parks and Wildlife, U.S. Coast Guard and Homeland Security may be present during weigh-in on August 12, 2017, or at other times throughout the tournament.
