Dear Property Owner:

Greetings from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT). WisDOT has begun work on the reconstruction of WIS 241 (27th Street) in the cities of Franklin and Oak Creek, in Milwaukee County. The project limits are just south of Drexel Avenue to just north of College Avenue.

The existing pavement on this section of WIS 241 (S. 27th St.) is highly deteriorated and does not provide accommodations for bicycles and pedestrians. Project improvements will include:

- Full reconstruction of the concrete pavement
- Modifying median openings to improve safety
- Adding bicycle and pedestrian accommodations
- Improving intersections
 - Adding and extending right and left turn lanes
 - Updating traffic signals

If you know the location of any of your property corners which abut the construction limits, have any existing drain or field tile, or a private irrigation system, please contact me directly.

Property owners that live adjacent to the S. 27th Street reconstruction project will most likely need to have their mailbox relocated during this project. The property owner is responsible for this action and not the contractor. Please contact your local post office for further direction and placement of your mailbox.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind everyone of the safety hazards around a construction project. Driving at a reduced speed will make it safer for everyone. Also, a highway project makes a very dangerous but attractive playground for children. Please warn them of the dangers and keep them clear of the construction area.
