Under general supervision, assist on site where needed, including but not limited to assisting with machinery equipped with scoops, shovels, or buckets, to excavate and load loose materials, haul equipment to and from job site, and install and service of septic systems. Assist in servicing equipment. Assist with onsite tasks as directed.

- Assist operator in setting up and inspecting equipment prior to operation.
- Observe hand signals, grade stakes, and other markings in assisting operator so that work can be performed to specifications.
- Become familiar with digging plans, machine capabilities and limitations, and with efficient and safe digging procedures regarding utilities in a given application.
- Assist operator in machinery to perform activities such as backfilling excavations, vibrating or breaking rock or concrete.
- Assist operator in creating and maintaining inclines and ramps, and handle slides, mud, and pit cleanings and maintenance.
- Assist in lubricating, adjusting, and repairing machinery, and replace parts such as gears, bearings, and bucket teeth, etc.
- Move materials to and around a construction site.
- Measure and verify levels of rock or gravel, bases, and other excavated material.
- Receive written or oral instructions regarding material movement or excavation.
- Adjust dig face angles for varying overburden depths and set lengths.
- Drive machines and haul equipment safely to work sites.
- Perform manual labor to prepare or finish sites, such as shoveling materials by hand. Operating hand compactor as needed, gluing pipe, assembling components of septic systems.
- Assist ground workers engaged in activities such as moving stakes or markers, or changing positions of towers.
- Assist operator in demolishing buildings using safe procedures as required by local, state and federal rules.
- Maintain all required records and documentation
- Assist in working with Subcontractors engaged in placing blocks and outriggers in order to prevent capsizing of machines when lifting heavy loads.

- Follow safety rules and regulations.
- Performs miscellaneous job-related duties as assigned.
- Enforce safety rules and regulations.
- Record regular inventory and complete required paperwork.
- Record information such as production or operational data on specified forms or reports Resolve worker problems or collaborate with coworkers to assist in problem resolution.

- Perform routine maintenance on vehicles and equipment such as checking oil, tires, etc.
