3. All entries must provide the driver proper visibility and control. Proper ventilation is a must.
4. **Any distribution of Candy or Promotional items must be passed out by persons walking
NO THROWING FROM FLOATS OR VEHICLES!!**
5. **NO WATER GUNS OR WATER BALLOON TOSSING.**
6. All entries must be physically able to maintain the parade pace.
7. The ultimate responsibility for safety lies with each individual entry.
8. The Taber Parade Committee assumes no responsibility in connection with, and makes no representation as to the safety of any parade entry, in whole or in part, solely by compliance with the parade rules and regulations.
9. Parade officials reserve the right to remove any entry, at any time, whether as a result of safety concerns, interference with parade's progress or any other reason officials deem necessary.
10. All vehicles and debris must be removed from LDS parking lot immediately after parade.
