

# BUSINESS OF THE YEAR AWARDS

he Business of the Year Award is presented to a business/organization able to demonstrate outstanding

leadership and vision, successful performance and substantial growth, and able to serve as an inspiration to other businesses. The award is designed to recognize and reward a business or organization that has invested in the region by creating economic success in the Greater Watertown Area and continually gives back to the community.

The annual Greater Watertown-North Country Chamber of Commerce Business of the Year Awards will be presented on Thursday March 23, 2017, at the Watertown Elks Lodge 496. Top organizations will be recognized during this prestigious event for their outstanding contributions to our community.

Award categories of recognition are open to all chamber members. Nominations include: Emerging Business Award, The Greater Watertown-North Country Farm and Craft Market Vendor of the Year, Non-Profit 50 or fewer, Non-Profit 51 or more, Small Business, and Large Business of the Year Award.

Companies and individuals may submit self-nominations or enter other companies. A distinguished panel of judges will review nomination forms, deliberate and choose a winner in each category.

If your organization has already previously won, you cannot nominate yourself again.

### **EMERGING BUSINESS AWARD**

Complete this section to be considered for the Emerging Business of the Year Award.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Any company that has been in business for five years or less and that has significant operations in Jefferson, Lewis, or St. Lawrence County. May not have previously won Emerging or Entrepreneur Business of the Year Award. Nominees do not need to be a Chamber member. Business cannot be a buy-out of an existing company.

### **CRITERIA**

Company will be recognized as an up and coming business based on the actual or potential growth of its business, innovative products, or services.

- 1. Give a brief background of the company's history.
- 2. Briefly describe the company's actual growth rate and potential growth.
- 3. Describe the company's products or services and their marketing strategies. (What gives them a competitive advantage?)
- 4. Describe the work environment and employee relations.
- 5. Describe major challenges the company has overcome.
- 6. List the company's community involvement in civic and non-profit groups.

## **NON-PROFIT AWARD**

Complete this section to be considered for the Non-Profit Business of the Year Award.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Any non-profit organization that is a 501(c) (3) organization and has been in operation for over five years. The organization must be a Greater Watertown-North Country Chamber member in good standing. May not have previously won a Non-Profit Business of the Year Award from the GWNCC.

#### CRITERIA

The organization is recognized as an outstanding model of mission achievement and community impact.

- 2. Briefly describe how the organization impact the community and their involvement.
- 3. What are the organization's most significant accomplishments?
- 4. Briefly describe customer service/client satisfaction. Identify any awards that may have been won.

## **SMALL BUSINESS AWARD**

Any for-profit company that has been in business for five years or more and a member of the Greater Watertown-North Country Chamber of Commerce in good standing. The organization must employ no more than 50 full-time and part-time employees. May not have previously won a Business of the Year Award from the GWNCC.

#### **CRITERIA**

Company will be recognized for demonstrating achievement and innovation in management, product development and having commitment to growth in the Greater Watertown-North Country region.

Company will be recognized for demonstrating achievement and innovation in management, product development and having commitment to growth in the Greater Watertown-North Country region.
