CAMPER CONTRACT

2017

Following are the rules for camping on the Fairgrounds during the dates of the 2016 Fair. The camping sites will be numbered. Registration will open up on June 26th. **YOU MUST MAKE YOUR RESERVATIONS IN PERSON WITH CASH OR CHECK. NO PHONE OR EMAIL RESERVATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** When you arrive at the Fair, please stop at the office to receive a permit to put in your camper window. The camping fees for this year are as follows: (This is for the four days.)

Slide-outs	\$120
30-amp	\$ 90
15-amp or no power	\$ 60

No water or sewer hook-ups. All holding tanks must be capped. Only one car or truck per lot.

No campers allowed before noon, Monday, July 17th. All campers must be in place no later than noon, Wednesday, July 19th. We would appreciate it if you stay for the duration of the Fair. All campers must leave by 8 p.m., Sunday, July 23rd.

All persons are required to pay a Daily Gate Admission - - Adults \$5, 10 & under free - - between 11:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. each day of the Fair. Season passes are available for \$15.00 per person.

The grounds are policed at all times during the Fair. However, **THE FAIR DOES NOT ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR ITEMS LOST OR DAMAGED, NOR FOR ANY PERSONAL INJURY.**

Policies:

1. Camping is restricted to the designated camping area located along the first West tree row.
2. Camping spots are approximately 15 X 30 feet. Only one car or pick-up truck is allowed per camping spot. All campers and vehicles need to have Camping stickers or they will be towed out of area.
3. All campers must get their assigned camping spot from the fair office and **camping fees must be paid before you park your camper.** Campers must park in their assigned spot. The fair board reserves the right to remove from the camping site any camper that violates this rule.
4. Tents are not allowed in the camping area, or anywhere on the fairgrounds.
5. Garbage must be bagged and deposited in containers provided. Dumping water or waste fluids on the ground is prohibited. Units with kitchen facilities and waste holding tanks must have their waste outlets capped.
6. If you have a 15 amp plug-in you need to limit your electrical usage.
7. No open fires, fire pits or burning is allowed.
8. Upon arrival, units with gas cylinders must check and tighten fittings.
9. Quiet hours are 11 pm. - 6 am.
10. Please respect other campers in the campgrounds.
11. The Fair Board reserves the right to enforce these rules. Violators may be asked to leave.
